#### Star Alliance Unveils Refurbished Lounge at Paris Charles de Gaulle

Star Alliance has officially completed the refurbishment of its lounge at Paris Charles de Gaulle (CDG) Airport. The 980 square meter facility offers seating for more than 220 guests and features stylish elements inspired by Parisian design and architecture. The lounge is available to First and Business Class customers as well as Star Alliance Gold members travelling from Paris Charles de Gaulle Airport – Terminal 1 on the following Star Alliance member airlines: Aegean, Air China, ANA, Asiana, EGYPTAIR, Eva Air, Singapore Airlines, Thai Airways, Turkish Airlines and United.

The lounge at Charles de Gaulle Airport, Terminal 1 is among seven other Star Alliance branded lounges, which are located at Amsterdam (AMS), Buenos Aires (EZE), Los Angeles (LAX), Nagoya (NGO), Rio de Janeiro (GIG) Rome (FCO) and Sao Paulo (GRU). ## • Ethiopian Cargo Launches Services to Libreville

The newly launched service comes as an addition to the current daily passenger flight to Gabon. The dedicated cargo flight is expected to facilitate the trade between Gabon and Ethiopia as well as developing the potential of Gabon to Ethiopian destinations in the rest of the world through connection via Addis Ababa which hosts one of the biggest cargo terminals in the world. The launch of the cargo service was marked with colorful cocktail celebration attended by business partners, government stakeholders and other invited guests. The

event was organized in collaboration with ATC-Cargo General Sales Agent in Paris and COREX Cargo Sales Agent in Libreville. The event also served as an opportunity to promote the new flight of ASKY to Johannesburg scheduled for launch on 15 June 2019. The Ethiopian code-shared ASKY flight will be operated four times a week directly to/from Libreville. Guests who attended the cocktail event expressed their appreciation for Ethiopian, ASKY and partners for the start of the cargo services in Gabon. They also promised to support the operations as it will create huge opportunities for the Gabon market.

## **Trekking Ethiopia's Simien Mountains**

Ethiopia is a land of legends and mystery – the Queen of Sheba and the Ark of the Covenant to name but two. The landscape is also mesmerising. In the far north are the Simien Mountains – a mystical world of primeval forests, misty peaks, bizarre plants and exotic creatures. Trekking these stunning highlands is like stepping into an otherworldly paradise Violent volcanic eruptions 40 million years ago created the Simien Mountains massif, which rises to over 4500m in northern Ethiopia. Over millennia, erosive forces have sculpted its jagged pinnacles, deep ravines and volcanic plugs. Treks of between five and ten days along high-altitude escarpments, across alpine meadows and through the fertile lowlands are the best way to fully appreciate the amazing diversity of the Simiens, much of what today is protected as part of Simien Mountains National Park...
