








Ethiopian Won the First Cargo Transportation Award in China

"We are developing Addis Ababa as the Dubai of Africa" Ethiopian Group CEO

Mr. Andreas Spaeth, an Editor of Airline Ratings, the world's best one-stop airline safety and product rating review website, was in Addis Ababa a couple of weeks ago for an interview with Ethiopian Group CEO Ato Tewolde GebreMariam. The interview covered topics including the leading position Ethiopian enjoys in Africa's aviation, the Airline's expanding destinations, fleet modernization and the like.

Reflecting on the emergence of Addis Ababa as a major hub along with the expansion of Bole International Airport, Ato Tewolde said, "We are doing this for the whole world, we are developing Addis Ababa as the Dubai of Africa."

The GCEO also shed some light on the role Ethiopian is playing in launching an open sky for Africa and bringing about cooperation among the continent's airlines saying, "Africa is the second biggest continent, but only generates less than 3 percent of worldwide air traffic. That's mostly due to the lack of liberalized transport markets. As Africa's biggest Airline we have to lead the integration and liberalization of Africa... We have created other hubs in Western Africa, besides Addis. That has enabled us to get around some of this protectionism. We also have an affiliated airline in Togo, ASKY, that flies now to 22 destinations in Western and Central Africa."



New simulator

Ethiopian Airlines acquired a full flight simulator for Airbus A350 aircraft. The simulator manufactured and supplied by the Canadian simulation technologies manufacturer, CAE, cost Ethiopian USD 15 million. The national flag carrier, which became the first African carrier to operate A350 jetliner in June 2016, is now the first airline in Africa to acquire the state-of-the-art simulator for A350 aircraft. Ethiopian Airlines Flight Operations department-owns simulators for B737, B757, B767, B777, B787 and Bombardier Q400 aircraft. It will also soon acquire B737MAX simulator. Senior executives of the airline, ambassadors of Canada, France, Germany, UK and Spain inaugurated the new simulator. ET Procures Five Airbus Simulators for \$20m



Ethiopian Airlines, the national carrier, has procured an Airbus full flight simulator for 20 million dollars.

The Airline imported full flight simulators for the Airbus A350 aircraft it had received in 2016. The procurement is expected to save foreign currency it has been paying to train its pilots in Toulouse, France.

The machines are fitted with complete electrical motion systems which save energy and have a low impact on the environment, Tewolde Gebremariam, Group CEO of Ethiopian Airlines said during the inaugural ceremony held last Friday.

Ethiopian has invested 125 million dollars over the past seven years to expand and upgrade all the facets of its training capabilities. The Pilot Training School of the Airline has trained pilots from over 52 countries, in Africa, the Middle East, Asia and Europe for around half a century.

Ethiopian Airlines, an aviation holding comprised of Ethiopian Express & Ancillary Services, Ethiopian International Services, Ethiopian Cargo Services, Ethiopian MRO Services, Ethiopian Aviation Academy, ET In-flight Catering, and Ethiopian Ground Services, currently operates seven Airbus aircrafts, with 17 more on the way. It also owns simulators for Boeing aircrafts and Bombardiers.

The Ethiopian Airports, on Wednesday announced that, it was making a massive investment on airport infrastructure to support the nation's socio-economic development.

sixth annual Africa Airport Expansion Summit was held at the Addis Ababa Radisson Blu Hotel. Endris Argaw, Marketing and Business development manager of Ethiopian Airports, disclosed that his company was undertaking the construction of seven regional airports. Hawassa, Semera, Jinka, Bale Robe and Shire are some of the regional airports which are under development. Endris said in addition to the regional airports under construction. Ethiopian Airports has started the construction of airfields for 7 new additional airports. Nekemt, Dembi Dolo, Mizan Aman, Metu, Dhremarkos, Yabelo and Negele Borena airfields are underdevelopment.

Ethiopian government committed to develop air transport service in the country. As a result, ten regional airports have been built in the past ten years," Endris said.











Ethiopian's Direct Flight to Belgium to Transport Flowers Takes Off

■ The Airlines plans to transport 130tns of flowers in three direct flights weekly

Ethiopian Airlines' direct freighter flight from Bahir Dar, the capital of Amhara Regional State, to Liege, Belgium, one of the largest Ethiopian flower destinations, took-off with 45tns of flowers on January 24, 2018.

The maiden flight shipped the products from Tana Flora, Ethio Agri-CEFT and Koga Veg Agricultural Development, the three horiculture farms among the 16 located in Bahir Dar. These 16 farms occupy 1,300ha of land secured from the Amhara Regional State.

"We aim to deliver fresh flowers timely and directly from the farms," said Tewolde Gebremariam, group CEO of Ethiopian Airlines, which has over 100 international and 21 local destinations.

The Airlines is planning to transport 130tns of flowers in three direct flights every weel

Among the 100 destinations of Ethiopian flowers, vegetables, herbs, cuttings and fruit products, Belgium leads importing over half of the products. Apart from Belgium and the European Union member state countries, the United States, Russia and the Middle East buy Ethiopian horticulture varieties.

Ethiopia is the fourth largest non-European Union (EU) member exporter to the EU cut flower market and the second largest flower exporter from Africa next to Kenya. The country has 12,552ha of land ideal for horticulture but only 11pc of this is cultivated with such varieties.

Companies in Bahir Dar have been struggling to transport the products to Bole International Airport, according to Nega Mekuanint, managing director of Tana Flora, one of the companies that shipped its products on the maiden

flight. Founded in October 2011 on 11ha of land, Tana shipped 30tns of flowers in the first trip.

"Most of our products get damaged while transporting them to Addis Abeba via road," said Nega, whose company targets to ship between 74tns and 90tns of flowers via air every week,

Ethiopian Airlines aims to support the export sector and the country's economy through such strategies. The country's import bill reached 17 billion dollars last year and is surging and it has struggled in boosting its export earnings stagnating at around three billion dollars for the past two years.

One of the major export items, horticulture, generated 271 million dollars last year- about 1.5pc lower than the preceding year's earnings. For the current iscal year, Ethiopia targets to earn 435 million dollars and half a billion dollars by the end of the second

edition of the Growth & Transformation Plan (GTP) from horticulture product exports.

The new addition will play a pivotal role in attracting many investors into the country, according to Tewodrose Zewde, executive director of Ethiopian Horticulture Producers & Exporters Association (EHPEA) with 75 active export businesses engaged in producing flowers, cuttings, ornamental plants, fruit, vegetables and herbs.

"As flowers are delicate, a safe logistics system is required," he said, "and if the country could manage to attain this, many foreign companies would join the sector," he told Fortune.

Ethiopian will avail similar freighter services from other flower producing regional states such as Hawassa, another region which is known for ample horticulture investments, according to Tewolde.

Ethiopian Employs New Cargo Packaging Solution

The national carrier, Ethiopian Airlines adopts new packaging technology for cargo shipments called Opticooler, a container equipped with self regulating battery-powered cooling compressors.

The agreement was signed with DoKaSch Temperature Solutions in February 2018. DoKaSch currently works with more than 20 major airlines and is based at Frankfurt International Airport, Germany, for positioning, maintenance and servicing of the units.

The Airlines is using the Opticooler technology to ship specific goods into the African market. It preserves perishable items especially pharmaceuticals well during the journey.

Inaugurated on June 29, 2017, the new Cargo Terminal-II accommodates a million tonnes of cargo a year.

Ethiopian is currently implementing a 15-year strategic plan, Vision 2025, for its seven business centres including Ethiopian Cargo Services.

Ethiopian, ASKY sign strategic partnership agreement with Guinea Airlines

Ethiopian Airlines has signed an agreement with Guinea Airlines for strategic partnership in management, maintenance and training.

Ethiopian Group CEO Tewolde Gebremariam, Cheick Dem, from Guinea Airlines and Guinea's Minister for Transport Oyé Guilavogui signed the agreement on January 30, 2018 at Ethiopian headquarters.

Tewolde said, the partnership is in line with the recently launched African Single Air Transport Market at the African Union Heads of State Summit in Addis Ababa.

"We are partnering with Guinea Airlines and other African countries because we have the capacity and the expertise to support our African brothers and sisters in the aviation sector."

Tewolde said, the agreement is a trilateral partnership with Guinea, ASKY Airlines and Ethiopian Airlines with a view to fill the air connectivity vacuum in domestic Guinea market and between the Mano River countries.

On behalf of Guinea Airlines CEO, Cheick Dem appreciated Ethiopian for the effort to realize the establishment of Guinea Airlines and also vowed to honor the terms of the agreement.
